This program is a specialized “Door-Through-Door” transportation service for seniors and disabled individuals who cannot drive. We can take you to a medical or dental appointment, dialysis, grocery store.... Scheduling a ride requires calling Care-A-Van (449-1117) at least 48 hours in advance of your appointment.
